The faithfulness of God to keep His promises to us is a certainty. He proved Himself time and time again in how He dealt with His people throughout the Old Testament. God has not changed since then. He is the same covenant-keeping God today as He was in Micah 7. Here are a few suggestions on how you and your family can reflect on the faithfulness of God:

- New Every Morning: Every morning when you wake up your children, take a minute to kneel beside the bed and pray Lamentations 3:22-23. Praise the Lord together that God's love is steadfast, that His mercies are new every morning, and that His faithfulness is great.
- We Are Changing But He Isn't: Take some time to look at family photos with your children. Talk together about how they have grown and changed since they were born. Let them see old photos of you so that they can see how much you have changed. Remind them that no matter how much people change God never changes. He is the same faithful and loving God today that He will be 10 years from now.

- How often do you remind your children of God's faithfulness so that they will have confidence in His fatherly care?

Prayer Points

- Pray that the Lord will open your eyes to see how unfaithful we are but how merciful God is to forgive us.
- Praise the Lord for keeping His covenant with us even when we are not faithful to Him.
