

CALL TO CONFESSION


Psalm 37:4-8

THE READING OF GOD'S WORD

John 13:31-35

When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him. If God is glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself, and glorify him at once. Little children, yet a little while I am with you. You will seek me, and just as I said to the Jews, so now I also say to you, 'Where I am going you cannot come.' A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

PRAYER & WORSHIP IN GIVING



SERMON

“Love Believes and Obeys,” Ephesians 6:1-6

I. We love well if we love with truth (vv. 1-2)

Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

II. We love well if we love in the light of obedience (vv. 3-6)

But sexual immorality and all impurity or covetousness must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints. Let there be no filthiness nor foolish talk nor crude joking, which are out of place, but instead let there be thanksgiving. For you may be sure of this, that everyone who is sexually immoral or impure, or who is covetous (that is, an idolater), has no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

Summary: As His children, we imitate God the Father by walking in the sacrificial redemptive love of the gospel of Jesus. Sexual immorality, impurity, and greed (or even talking about those things) are empty perversions of love that selfishly consume and destroy. In contrast, Christ's love for us and in us is a love that gives, redeems, and builds up.


THE LORD'S SUPPER

Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost!




