

SERVICE OF THE WORD

CALL TO WORSHIP

Psalm 9:1-2

We begin our gathered worship by directing our attention toward God through the reading of selected scriptures which invite our worship. This prepares us to worship in spirit and truth and reminds us that it is God who invites us to enjoy Him through worship.

CALL TO CONFESSION

Matthew 20:20-26

Then the mother of the sons of Zebedee came up to him with her sons, and kneeling before him she asked him for something. And he said to her, "What do you want?" She said to him, "Say that these two sons of mine are to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your kingdom." Jesus answered, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I am to drink?" They said to him, "We are able." He said to them, "You will drink my cup, but to sit at my right hand and at my left is not mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared by my Father." And when the ten heard it, they were indignant at the two brothers. But Jesus called them to him and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. It shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be your slave, even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

1 John 2:1b-2

But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world

Understanding that, apart from Christ, we cannot meet God's standard of righteousness as revealed in His word, we pray to God, confessing our sins together as a congregation, both sins of commission and sins of omission. We also ask God to forgive our sin because of Christ's atoning work on our behalf and to transform us into the likeness of Christ by the power of Holy Spirit.

The reader assures the members of the congregation, on the authority of God's word, that the one who confesses and repents of his sin and believes the gospel—that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures—is freely pardoned by God.

THE READING OF GOD'S WORD

Colossians 3:22-4:4

Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality. Masters, treat your bondservants justly and fairly, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven. Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison — that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.

THE PREACHING OF GOD'S WORD

Ephesians 6:5-9, "Laboring and Leading," Jeremy Wright

Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free. Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.

I. We work as servants of Christ (vv. 5-8)

A. We work whole-heartedly

B. We work honestly

C. We work for reward

II. We lead under Christ's authority (v. 9)

A. We lead with gentleness & humility before the face of God

B. We lead in affirming the dignity of all people
