

## **CALL TO CONFESSION**

*Hebrews 4:12-13*

---

For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

*Understanding that, apart from Christ, we cannot meet God's standard of righteousness as revealed in His word, we pray to God, confessing our sins together as a church, both sins of commission and sins of omission. We also ask God to forgive our sin because of Christ's atoning work on our behalf and to transform us into the likeness of Christ by the power of Holy Spirit.*

*Our reader assures us, on the authority of God's Word, that all who confess and repent of their sin and believe the gospel—that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures—are freely pardoned by God.*

Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
